In August 2015, OIG received information that a former Amtrak Coach Cleaner had a violent criminal history, including arrests and convictions for assault and murder. We interviewed him in January 2016, and he admitted to having a violent criminal history and failing to disclose this to Amtrak on his employment application. After the interview concluded, he voluntarily resigned, surrendered his Amtrak employment identification badge, and was escorted off Amtrak property by a member of the Amtrak Police Department.
