

Summary: Allegations Not Substantiated that Business Received Contracts Based on False Certifications

Report Date: October 17, 2017

OIG investigated allegations that an electrical service and supply company received contracts from the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation (USBR) by falsely claiming the company was a women-owned small business concern.

Our investigation did not substantiate the allegations. We confirmed the company was awarded three contracts with USBR, but the contracts were awarded based on the Set-Aside for Small Business preference not for women-owned companies as alleged.

This is a summary of a report we provided to the USBR for any action deemed appropriate.
