

Summary: Allegations of Contract Fraud on Crow Reservation, MT

Report Date: July 20, 2015

OIG completed an investigation into allegations that a Crow Tribe, MT, contractor failed to provide computer equipment and services for which it had been paid \$1,500,665 through its contract with the tribe. Our investigation found that the contractor did fail to provide some of the computer equipment purchased by the Crow Tribe; however, there was insufficient evidence to establish fraud. We referred our investigation to the United States Attorney for the District of Montana, who declined to prosecute.
