

Summary: Investigation of National Park Service Maintenance Supervisor

Report Date: October 1, 2015

We assisted the National Park Service's (NPS) Investigative Services Branch (ISB) in an investigation of allegations that an NPS maintenance division supervisor at Grand Teton National Park, WY, purchased equipment (furnace, stove, and other appliances and hardware), with his Government credit card and then converted those items to his personal use.

Our investigation substantiated only minor violations. The employee admitted to reclaiming some discarded Government property and to using his Government computer and cell phone to assist in operating his personal rental business.

ISB referred the results of this investigation to NPS.
